ORDER

THALAGHATPURA LAKE

On behalf of the complainant Sri H.S.Doraiswamy, Sri Lakshmikanth and Miss.Chaintanya are present along with Sri Babu. Sri Bhat, Law Officer is present along with Sri D.R.Kumaraswamy, Regional Senior Environmental Officer of Karnataka State Pollution Control Board (herein after for short KSPCB), Bengaluru. Sri Chandrashekar, Assistant Executive Engineer is present on behalf of the BWSSB. On behalf of the BBMP Smt.Bupradha, Assistant Executive Engineer is present.

2) On behalf of the complainant, a letter dated 7.12.2018 is filed by Miss.Chaitanya setting out the issues that are required to be attended by the authorities concerned. It is useful to extract the said letter which reads as follows –

"Thalaghattapura Lake

Located in Hemmigepura ward (RR Nagar) covers an area of 19 acres 16 guntas. According to Koliwad Committee Report, 2 acres 29 guntas has been encroached.

Current Issues:

- The lake has a continuous inflow of untreated sewage that flows through multiple entries having resulted in frothing in the lake.
- This also has led to the excessive growth of water Hyacinths.
- Sight of the sewage flowing across the road (culvert), stench and mosquitoes adds to the woes.
- The lake has not been maintained, though it was developed by BDA and handed over to BBMP.
- Dumping of construction debris on the lake bed and increasing day by day.
- Dumping and burning of mixed waste (including hair from saloons)
- Open defaecation continues on the lake bed.

Solutions suggested:

- Complete the remaining fencing around the encroached area. Survey of the lake is yet to be completed and encroachment cleared.
- Address the sewage inlet issue by laying UGD / STP in the area on priority basis.
- Address the open defecation issue by building and maintaining public toilets around the area. The honourable Justice has already passed the order on this, which is to be implemented on priority.
- Ensure maintenance of the lake once the lake is completely rejuvenated."

- 3) A copy of the said letter is also furnished to all the authorities. The authorities concerned may examine the issue raised and address the issues for the purpose of rejuvenation, protection and maintenance of lake.
- 4) Sri Chandrashekar, Assistant Executive Engineer, appearing on behalf of BWSSB submitted that they have taken-up the work of providing Under Ground Drainage system for 110 villages within the limits of BBMP and the same is planned for three years and work will be carried out in phased manner.
- Smt.Bupradha, Assistant Executive Engineer of BBMP, Bengaluru submitted that since, now the State Government has sanctioned ₹5 crores for the development of the lake, the BBMP would take effective steps for the development of the lake with the assistance and co-operation of BWSSB and KSPCB. The said statement is placed on record. The Assistant Executive Engineer further submitted that since the Government has sanctioned the finance only on 1.2.2019, the BBMP has to take steps for tender process to entrust the work to the contractor and for other developmental activities.

According to her, it will take 6 to 8 months to rejuvenate and carry out necessary work for development of the lake.

- there is an encroachment in respect of the portion of the lake, it is necessary to get the lake resurveyed by the survey department to protect the said lake. In the light of the submission made, the Joint Director of Land Records, Bengaluru Urban District and the jurisdictional Tahsildar are directed to get the land, surveyed and point out the encroachment portion if any within a period of eight weeks from today.
- Records, Bengaluru South and the Tahsildar, Bengaluru South. They are directed to file the Status Report with regard to the survey conducted before the Lokayukta within a period of eight weeks time from today. After serving of the copy of the Status Report to the complainant and all the authorities, on such survey being done, the BBMP and the Tahsildar to take effective steps for eviction of the unauthorized encroachment

and file the Status Report. The authorities of BBMP, BWSSB and KSPCB is given ten weeks time to file their Status Report.

Communicate this Order to all the parties concerned. List this case on 25th April 2019 at 3.00 p.m.
