

- 3.1.3 RESPONSIVE PUBLIC SERVICES
 - 3.1.3.1 To make available equitably, responsive and timely delivered public services to all citizens of civic agencies/authorities, such as BBMP, BESCOM, BWSSB, and BDA, in all Wards.
 - 3.1.3.2 To bring in empirical metrics i.e. measurement of services for their effectiveness and publish timely Report Cards to be made available to the public;
- 3.2 To Empirically, Exponentially Emancipate apathy of authorities public with no distinction of caste, creed, religion, region or any other divisive parameters, to create better living conditions.

- 3.3 To undertake any project, scheme, activity of any sort with an objective of protection and promotion of interests of the Residents of the RANGE.
- 3.4 To make members Emanate as best, responsible citizens and to be participative in the civic administration to create optimum results for the betterment of residents by improving infrastructure, basic civic amenities and necessities.
- 3.5 To ensure proper coordination with concerned authorities at all levels, alleviating ailments to residents of including governments at the centre and the states of India and abroad, and improve living conditions of residents or the entire neighbourhood in the vicinity irrespective of whether they are members or not and notwithstanding the fact that specific power may not have been given by any such member or neighbour for representing them.
- 3.6 To effect Civic, Cultural, Social, Transcendental, Sportsman Spirit, Personality, Patriotic, Economical, Ecological, Environmental, Educational, Emotional development, Especially and not Exclusively, of the members, and also of the society at large
- 3.7 To carry out within the RANGE any welfare activities including Games & Sports, ladies club, club, relatives, kids parks/joints, for members, and public, which results in welfare of residents of Bengaluru and also Karnataka.
- 3.8 To work for the betterment of residents of Bengaluru or such other expanded areas of membership as may be decided from time to time by the General Meeting, either on arrangement,

cooperation, coordination, affiliation, association, in the form of forum, Joint action committees, program specific unification etc.

- 3.9 To carry on any activity with a view to generate surplus which may augment the achievement of objects of the Confederation mentioned above, even if the same is normally considered commercial, with a non profit motive, subject to the provisions of statutes that control the Confederation.
- 3.10 To expand the horizons to creation of universal brotherhood
- **3.11** The President of the Confederation is authorised to correspond with the Registrar of Societies
- **3.12** The confederation intends to apply it profits, if neither any nor other income in promoting its objectives and prohibit the payment of any dividend or distribution of any income or profits among its members.

PREAMBLE

A Non-Profit Oriented sovereign Confederation, formed on 24th August, 2013 registered under Karnataka Societies Act, 1960 & other relevant authorities as per statutory requirements, of, by and for residents of Bengaluru or for residents as may be expanded from time to time or which is for the betterment of members/residents or for the entire RANGE including all blocks, phases and stages and which may include any further neighbourhood to achieve communion, fraternity through social, cultural, sports, welfare activities for development and betterment of community of residents in particular and society at large, having the following by-laws and objects as per Memorandum of Association.

1. ADDRESS

- **1.1.**Present address: 3J, NA Chambers, 3rd Cross, 7th C Main, 3rd Block, KormangalaBengaluru 560034.
 - 1.2. The address may be changed by a resolution of the board as per the provisions of the Act
 - 1.3. The office of the Confederation shall function from any premise within the RANGE. However, the members in board may by simple majority

approve of office outside the RANGE for convenience, in addition to office within the RANGE.

1.4. The books of accounts and other records shall be at the office address or at such other places as may be resolved by the board

2. AMENDMENTS

- 2.1. The Memorandum or Rules of the association may be revised, altered, or amended at Special General Body meeting of the BRACE specially called for the purpose but only by an affirmative vote in favour of at least three times the votes cast against it of the members present and voting at such meeting and provided that the exact text of the proposed change together with notice that changes are to be considered, shall have been circulated to the members by the Managing Committee at least 21 days prior to the date of the meeting.
- **2.2.** No amendment shall be made inconsistent with Income tax clauses specified elsewhere in the memorandum and any amendment shall be consistent with the provisions of Karnataka Societies Registration Act, 1960 and subject to filing/approval requirements of that Act,


3. COMMON SEAL

3.1. A round seal of the Confederation be made as the 'Common Seal' of the Confederation, which shall indicate the signature of the Confederation, if passed by a resolution of the board and signed by a person authorised in the resolution and witnessed by at least 1 office bearer or employee approved by resolution in this behalf.

3.2. The seal shall be in the custody of the secretary and it shall never be used except by the authority of the Managing Committee previously given.

4. BOOKS OF ACCOUNTS

- **4.1.** The financial Year of BRACE shall be April 1st to March 31st of the following calendar year
- 4.2. For the first year the same shall be from incorporation till 31st March
- **4.3.** The accounts of the Confederation shall be prepared for the financial year and the same shall be presented before the AGM after audit.
- **4.4.** The books of accounts shall be available for inspection at the office or at such other place as determined by the board and members can inspect the same by giving 48 hours prior notice.
- **4.5.** The board shall have power not to circulate the copies of the accounts if the same is kept for inspection during the entire notice period in the office or such other place during normal business hours. However, the members in GM may overrule this power.
- **4.6.** The books will be maintained on cash basis of accounting unless and until the board decides to follow mercantile basis.
- **4.7.** Each year the financial statements to be prepared would be the Balance Sheet, Income and Expenditure account and the Receipts and payments account. Vertical format as prescribed under Companies Act, 1956 may be used as standard format.

5. MEMBERS

5.1.TYPES OF MEMBERS

There will be four classes of Membership:

Active Membership

- Association Membership
- Honorary Membership
- Allied Membership

5.1.1 Active Membership

5.1.1.1. Active Membership Shall be open to individuals who are nominated by Namma Bengaluru Foundation at incorporation or later and subscribes to the memorandum of BRACE. The Chairman of Namma Bengaluru Foundation will be President of BRACE.

- 5.1.1.2 Active members will form the Board or Managing Committee
- **5.1.2** Board or Managing Committee shall be out of Active members- will form the **Association Membership**
 - **5.1.2.1** Association Membership may be granted to RAs' and such other bodies or persons recommended by board and accepted by simple majority of executive council of the RANGE.
 - 5.1.2.2 There will be no fees for Association Membership and may be altered by Board in accordance with the Act.
 - 5.1.2.3 The Association Members can hold office and vote in RAs' Executive Council Meetings.

5.1.3 Honorary Membership

5.1.3.1 An honorary membership can be conferred upon an individual upon the recommendation of the Managing Committee or by approval

by simple majority of the members at a GM or by approval of the Board on recommendation by Executive Council Meetings.

- 5.1.3.2 Honorary membership shall be granted only to individuals who have made outstanding contribution to the society.
- 5.1.3.3 Honorary Members shall not be required to pay entrance fee or annual fee.

5.1.4 Allied Membership

- 5.1.4.1 Allied membership will be available to any organisation who subscribes to the memorandum of the BRACE and has genuine interest and are able to contribute to the welfare of the Confederation. They may be within or outside the RANGE.
- 5.1.4.2 Allied members are to be accepted by the absolute majority of the board
- 5.1.4.3 There will be no fee for allied members.

5.2 MEMBERSHIP

- 5.2.1 Any resident or association could subscribe to the Confederation and on acceptance by the board, become member of Executive Council.
- 5.2.2 There will be no fees for regular or active membership
- 5.2.3 The Qualification for membership could be revised by a resolution of the GM
- 5.2.4 One membership for each RA's will be taken into account for Confederation elections.
- 5.2.5 Membership is not transferable

5.2.6 On transfer or termination of Resident association, membership terminates

5.3 FEES

5.3.1 One time entrance fee

- 5.3.1.1 All the RAs shall be liable to pay admission fee subscribed to Confederation or not, since the benefits will extend to all residents. At present it is NIL
- **5.3.1.2** However, the Confederation will account the same only on receipt basis.

5.3.2 Annual membership fee

- **5.3.2.1** Annual membership fee may be fixed and revised by simple majority of members in a GM as per the provisions of the Act
- 5.3.2.2 Annual fees shall be payable in advance by the 1st January of every year failing which such members shall have to pay a penalty of 1% p.m. or such revised rate of interest. However, the penalty clause will be effective only when the board implements it and the board will have power to waive or modify penalty.
- 5.3.2.3 In the event of non-payment of annual subscription even after 30th April, the membership shall be suspended and can be renewed only after payment of penalty and fees. In case of members with membership fees pending for over 3 Months from the 30th April deadline, membership shall ipso facto stand cancelled and they have to apply fresh for their membership.

5.3.3 Specific Project/activity fees

- 5.3.3.1 The board may from time to time based on the need of the Confederation activities for specific projects work out the fees that is needed to accomplish the objectives through activities or projects of the Confederation. Each project will be kept in separate fund and accounted for, however RA control or spearheading the project, may be consulted but cannot claim control over the project or money, on account of proximity, relevance, interest or contribution. Board will be the trustee for the fund and BRACE will have right of cypress.
- 5.3.3.2 The Board or Managing Committee is empowered to set the date for receiving due and levy penalties for late payment and as and when there are subscription rate increases in the midterm.

Event Participation fee

5.3.3The Board may charge participation fee of the RAs' members for any function/event etc. that may be deemed fit to be organized by the BRACE for the benefit and welfare of the members at large.

5.3.4 Event participants may be residents or non-residents as may be allowed from time to time by the board.

5.4 CODE OF CONDUCT

The members shall observe the following Code of Ethics:

- **5.4.1** The members shall work towards achievement of advancement of objects.
- 5.4.2 The members shall work only for the benefit of the organisation
- 5.4.3 The members shall follow the rules and regulations of BRACE. Members shall follow decorum and decency in any meetings, events or any other get-togethers and BRACE shall have the right to discipline members not behaving and in this regard, the event/project in-charge or the board members can take decision, however the chairman shall have final authority.
- 5.4.4 The Managing Committee shall have the right to suspend or determine any membership if found to resort to practices contrary to the objects of the BRACE, such members however shall be given adequate opportunity to explain.
- **5.4.5** Any member found not adhering to the rules and regulation or working against the interest of members/Confederation shall be disqualified to be member, suspended from Confederation
- **5.4.6** A suspended member on recommendation by either a Board or a disciplinary committee, after enquiry, be continued or removed from membership
- **5.4.7** A suspended member is not eligible to contest in election for office bearer or be part of committee or task force till reinstatement

6. GRIEVANCES AND DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS:

- **6.1.** The conduct of members of BRACE shall be expected at all times to Be in accordance with the provision of the code of ethics and policies adopted By the BRACE
- **6.2.** A complaint against a member of BRACE may be filed formally with the Secretary or to a committee formed in this behalf. It shall be required to set forth facts of the complaint in general terms and may not be ruled invalid for want of specific details. Justice, equity and good conscience shall be the rule for dealing with complaints.
- 6.3. When a complaint is received the board/relevant committee shall make an assessment and rec rd their reasons in writing about their decision. When board has reason to believe that complaint needs to be investigated it the same may be referred to committee. Committee shall investigate by issuing notice to the party complained against within 15 days from the receipt, whose replay and be filed within 2 weeks from the receipt or in suitable cases may be extended by another 2 weeks. Findings of the committee will be sent to the board and board shall have final authority on making an order of findings. Board may accept the findings and punish the member as per recommendation or on its own moderate punishment, ask for re-enquiry, reject the findings of committee.
- **6.4.** The board shall make an attempt to resolve the complaint between members, satisfactory by itself. In case if the complaint is concerned with member and the public, it can resolve it unless it is prohibited by law to do so.

7. BOARD

7.1. The Management of "BRACE" shall be vested in the Board

7.2. The Board or the Managing committee shall comprise

- 7.2.1. President
- 7.2.1. Vice-President
- 7.2.2 Secretary
- 7.2.3 Treasurer
- 7.2.4 Eleven members

and such other posts as may be approved by GM to be part of Board and amend as per the provisions of the Act. The total number of office bearers shall not exceed 15.

7.3.All the members who constitute the Board or Managing Committee of BRACE, other than the nominated Persons, shall be elected from among the Active Members of the confederation at the Annual General Meeting.

7.4.The members of the Board so elected shall meet within 7 days from the date of election and further elect the office bearersnamely, President, Vice President, Secretary , Treasurer and members.

7.5.The tenure of Board will be for 5 years, but in the event of not conducting election for the next board for some reason, they can continue till such election in any subsequent AGM.

7.6.The board shall be elected by simple majority of Active Members present at the AGM

7.7. The board may co-opt office bearers for casual vacancies arising on account of resignation or removal or death of office bearers by absolute majority. The board shall have power to co-opt the office bearers within overall limit, in case of necessity for administration.

7.8.The office bearers' tenure commences on election in GM and the preceding board shall handover in a board meeting after such election.

7.9.At the expiration of the tenure of the office of a Managing Committee and when a new committee is elected at the Annual General Body Meeting, The President, Secretary and Treasurer shall handover the correspondence files Accounts books, Bank Pass Book, The seal of BRACE and other property belonging to the incoming Managing Committee.

7.10. No office bearer shall enter into any commitment on behalf of the Confederation unless specifically authorized to do so by a Resolution passed by the Managing Committee.

8. POWERS OF BOARD:

The Board shall have the following powers




